




Contact your club

Your club manager will need to receive your record form and Thank You notes before your auction check can be released to you. Good Luck to all that will be competing in the major livestock shows!!

### LIVESTOCK PROJECT RECORD FORMS

It's time to start finishing up your project record forms...these get confused with the Texas 4-H Recordbook, but are **very different**. <u>*The Livestock Project Record Form*</u> is filled out by 4-H livestock exhibitors in regards to their livestock project. The Project Record Form teaches the skill of record keeping, along with showing progress, growth and accomplishments in your livestock project. The record form needs to be given to your club manager along with your thank you notes to buyers as soon as possible after the Medina County Jr Livestock Show.

<u>The 4-H Livestock Project Record Form</u> is located on the Medina County Extension website (medina.agrilife.org) under publications, livestock, 4-H Livestock Project Record Form



Along with the theme category there are 14 other categories in which to enter. Each county may have one entry per category.

Entries will be taken between April 1-15th, 2023

**Categories for 2022-2023** are Animals-Domestic, Animals-Wildlife, Catch-All, Details and Macro, Elements of Design, Enhanced, Food, Landscape and Nature, Leading Line, Long Exposure, Motion/ Action, People, Plant/Flora, Shadow/Silhouette, the 2022-2023 Theme "Reflections".

# 4 H Recordbooks

Keeping records is a great way to hold on to your memories about your incredible adventures in 4-H. Record keeping is also a great way to develop skills in time management, communication, setting goals and deadlines, money management and project evaluations. In an effort to update the current record book system a committee has developed an online program with a data entry system that easily allows for updates, editing and printing.

- There will be three (3) levels of record books based on 4-H age (junior, intermediate, and senior). Information requested for each level will progressively add on to each other. The junior & intermediate books are significantly simplified from past record books. The senior level book is similar to the past record book with some minor edits.
- Parts of the report form will be standardized to allow for ease of completion and judging.
- Much of the data from previous record books that a member may have saved on their home computer may be "cut and pasted" into the new form.
- All 4-H members will begin using the new online forms or a new paper form that is available for download from the Texas 4-H website.
- Record books will still be printed and turned in (in hardcopy form) to be judged by the deadline June 12th.

Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarships are academic scholarships awarded each year to applicants based on their academic record, 4-H experience, and financial need (for scholarships for which it is a required criterion). The scholarship program is overseen by the Texas 4-H Youth Development Foundation. An estimated \$2.2 million will be given at the Texas 4-H Roundup Scholarship Assembly. Scholarship values range from \$3000-\$20,000 with over 200 scholarships being awarded in 2022. For more information go to:

### **TEXAS 4-H AGE AND YEAR REQUIREMENTS**

Youth may participate in 4-H from September 1st of grade 3 through August 31st following completion of grade 12 with these restrictions:

Texas 4-H will have new membership eligibility based on SCHOOL GRADE not age. The new eligibility rules and guidelines are:

Minimum age—8 (in addition to being in the 3rd grade)

Maximum age—18 (as of August 31, 2022)

SENIOR: Grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 INTERMEDIATE: Grades 6, 7, and 8 JUNIOR: Grades 3, 4, and 5


